30 or 15 hour Codes and EYR1 Forms

Just a little reminder that if you became or will become eligible for the working parent's entitlement, this will be increasing to 30 hours for all children (2,3 and 4 year olds) with effect from September, BUT you will need to have applied for it before the end of August for it to be eligible for the term starting in September. PLEASE speak to Cathy if you need help to get this done! (We would prefer to know that you have your code sorted before we break up for the holidays!) If you already have a code, then don't forget to 'reconfirm' it with HMRC when prompted to do so. We are hoping to start using an online Funding Form system from September, so it will all be digital, and no long forms or pieces of paper to
