## Our new Premises!!

So, Argyle Morley UR Church is now officially our new home, and we hope you love it as much as we do! It will take us all a little while to get used to the change and to establish new ways of managing things, so please do bear with us as we settle in!

A few important things to keep in mind that will help us along the way....

- We still have to set up on a Monday and then pack everything away on the Friday and our storage space is quite tight, so please help us by making sure you empty your child's basket on the last day that they attend in a week. (we stack them up to pack them away!)
- Please also remember any coats, buggies, bags etc so that we are not left storing more than we need to! (especially at the weekends)
- Please be patient if we don't get to the door right away, but if we don't hear the doorbell, or the gates are still locked and you can't get through, then just give us a call on the mobile (07495624643)
- Please remember to label your child's coats, lunch boxes, bags, and anything else they might easily lose! This will help us make sure everyone gets the right things back at the end of the day.
- Please note that the Car Park is available to use for drop-offs first thing in the morning and then at 12 noon and after 3pm BUT it is also our outdoor play area and so the gates will be locked at 9.30am and only reopened at 12 for a short time, and not again until 3pm.
- It is lovely to be able to talk to parents at drop off and pick up times, but please also be aware that supervising the children is the staff's top priority, and there are times (especially Lunch times) when it is essential that we have enough staff focusing on the children. Please therefore try to limit conversations at these times I man you!

(Especially when there may not be anyone else to check in on you and see that you are ok!)
